Course Overview - This course complies with Pennsylvania's 24-hour Pre-licensing Education requirement. The course is structured over a 3-day period with classes beginning each day at 8:30 a.m. and concluding at 5:00 p.m. An optional webcast is presented prior to class to assist students in understanding the licensing exam process. Course Material - Students will be shipped a study manual, Flash Cards, Focus Notes and a Pennsylvania Licensing Information Bulletin and access to Exam Master Online.
